In the furtherance of God's mission through the Church, the Munderloh Foundation provides, where needed, financial assistance to students preparing for the parish pastoral ministry of the Lutheran Church.

The Trustees of the Foundation believe that, as Christians, we nurture, edify and educate one another for the Christian faith and life, and in the face of the great unfinished task of witnessing Christ in word and deed, we should encourage the recruitment of students to study for and enter the ministry of the Lutheran Church.
